Treating traumatised children requires specialised experience and so IR has partnered with a local NGO, Amica Educa, that helps women and children with psychological problems. Amica Educa offers a variety of services for traumatised women and children. An SOS helpline is provided for crisis support, painting groups are organised for children, teenagers and adults under 18.
